

COOKIE POLICY - TRIALING HEALTH, S.L.

(hereinafter referred to as "**TRIALING**")

In compliance with the duty of information set out in section 2 of Article 22 of Law 34/2002, of 11 July, on Information Society Services and Electronic Commerce, the purpose of this cookie policy is to inform users clearly and precisely about the cookies used by the www.trialing.org website.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies and other similar technologies such as local shared objects, flash cookies or pixels, are small files that web servers send to your computer to store and retrieve information about your visitors, as well as to provide proper functioning of the site.

The use of these devices allows the web server to remember some data concerning the user, such as their preferences for viewing the pages of that server (country, language, etc.), name and password, products they are most interested in, etc. in order to improve the services offered and contribute to a better browsing experience for the user.

WHAT IS THE RETENTION PERIOD?

Depending on the duration, a distinction can be made between:

- **Session cookies:** cookies designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a website.
- **Persistent cookies:** cookies in which the data remain stored in the device and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the party responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.

WHO OWNS THE COOKIES?

According to their ownership they can be distinguished:

- **First-party cookies:** these are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.
- **Third-party cookies:** these are cookies that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies.

WHAT COOKIES ARE USED ON WWW.TRIALING.ORG?

Different types of cookies are used on the website for different purposes. The cookies used are listed below:

Category: Necessary Cookies

Necessary cookies make the website usable by enabling basic functions such as website navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Category: Marketing cookies

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors on websites. The intention is to show relevant and attractive advertisements to the individual user, and therefore more valuable to publishers and third-party advertisers.

Category: Statistics cookies

Statistics cookies collect information about how you use a website, like which pages you visited and which links you clicked on.

WHO IS THE CONTROLLER?

TRIALING, LTD. is the Data Controller of the personal data of the Data Subject and informs you that this data will be processed in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (GDPR), for which you are provided with the following processing information:

- **Purposes of processing:** as specified in the section on cookies used on this website.
- **Legitimation of the processing:** with the exception of necessary cookies, the basis of legitimacy of the processing is the consent of the data subject (art. 6.1.a) RGPD). For necessary cookies, the basis of legitimacy is the legitimate interest of the data controller (6.1.f) RGPD).
- **Data retention criteria:** as specified in the section on cookies used on the website.

- **Communication of data:** data will not be communicated to third parties, except in cookies owned by third parties or by legal obligation.
- **International data transfers:** This website uses cookies from US providers so it is likely that your data will be transferred to or stored in the US. Please note that the EU, following the Schrems II ruling, **no longer recognises the Privacy Shield as a valid mechanism for complying with data protection requirements when transferring personal data to the US, so your data may not be adequately protected in the US.** Therefore, the aforementioned companies have announced that their processing of personal data will be legitimised in the Standard Contractual Clauses. **TRIALING, LTD.** is monitoring the transparency documentation published by the aforementioned companies and is in the process of evaluating the supplementary mechanisms proposed by them. HOW TO CHANGE THE COOKIE SETTINGS?

Cookie settings panel

From the cookie configuration panel, you can configure the cookies that the website can install in your browser, except for technical or functional cookies that are necessary for browsing and using the different options or services offered.

Modify cookies from the browser

Remember that you can also restrict, block or delete cookies from **TRIALING**, or any other website using your browser.

Delete cookies from your device	Cookies that are already on a device can be deleted by clearing the browser history, which deletes cookies from all websites visited. However, some of the saved information (e.g. login data or website preferences) may also be lost.
Manage site-specific cookies	To have more precise control over site-specific cookies, users can adjust their privacy and cookie settings in their browser.
Blocking cookies	Although most modern browsers can be configured to prevent cookies from being installed on your device, this may require you to manually adjust certain preferences each time you visit a site or page. In addition, some services and features may not work properly (e.g. profile logins).
